I wanted to let you know that last weekend was a very special time for me in Key Largo. After sustaining a spinal cord injury and living in a wheelchair for the past six years, getting back to scuba diving was a top priority of mine. This past weekend not only proved that I can still dive, but with the assistance of the Pegasus Thruster, I can truly dive with ease. After meeting you and your company at the 2009 DEMA show, I was extremely impressed with your technology but was slightly skeptical about how well it would work for a person with my level of injury. Some of the initial concerns I had included ease of setup, capability of using your push button technology, battery life and overall use of your product while I was in the water. I want to let you know that not only did your Pegasus Thruster calm every one of my concerns, but it completely beat every expectation that I had.

While heading out to our first dive site, I was shocked as you were giving me a short introduction on the Pegasus Thruster and watching you set it up on my tank. The ease of your “snap on” style technology and connecting the actual Thruster, battery and bracket took less the three minutes to fully assemble. I rarely can connect and assemble my regulators to my BC and tank as fast as your Thruster was connected and ready to go.

I must admit that after securing your push button to my hand, I was still a little nervous as to how well the Thruster would work for me after descending down to the reef. From the first push of that button I was in a state of shock as to what it felt like to fly around in the water especially because I have very limited use of my legs. It was an emotional time for me to be virtually independent again while diving and to actually get around faster than ever before. It was amazing, that within a few minutes time, I was out of my wheelchair and enjoying scuba diving just like I did before I was hurt. The Pegasus Thruster gave me a moment in time where I felt like I had no disability at all. Although we were unable to dive the second day due to weather issues and get the video footage of us using the Pegasus Thruster, I wasn't extremely upset. All I had to do is remember back to the prior day and enjoy the freedom I felt while diving with the Pegasus Thruster.



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I want to thank you and your company again for creating such an amazing product and for my time with you all in Key Largo.
